

## Practical Guide: Composting in Grosbreuil



Welcome to our local community initiative!

By participating in collective composting, you can transform your waste into "black gold" while preventing tonnes of organic matter from being incinerated.

## The Composting Process in 5 Steps

### Step 1: Sorting at home



- Fill your compost bin with your peelings, coffee grounds.
- **The Grosbreuil advantage:** We also collect your hedge trimmings and branches to produce the mulch needed to balance the compost..

### Step 2: Moving to the hut (Weighing))



- **Weigh** your compost bin with the scales when you arrive..
- **Announce the weight as well as your bioseau number** to the permanent staff member present.
- *Why?* These data measure the ecological impact of our municipality within the Community of Municipalities.

### Step 3: Depositing into the swath



- Empty your compost bin directly onto the top of the long compost heap (the windrow) that is being filled.
- Distribute the waste evenly to help the micro-organisms.

### Step 4: The secret of the mixture



- **Watering:** Lightly moisten your additions (using the garden hose on site) to activate bacterial life.
- **Covering:** Add a shovelful of mulch (available on site) and cover your organic waste generously (at least 3 times the contents of your organic waste bin).).

### Step 5: The circle is complete



- Thanks to your efforts, waste becomes a rich fertiliser for our land.
